Garden Class Themes
Autumn Term 2019

English

The children will further develop their understanding of sentence structure and what a sentence needs. We will look at different word classes and apply this learning to make our sentences exciting.

The children will learn about the features of different genres of writing, such as stories, letter writing, information texts and instructions.

Numeracy

The children will further develop their understanding of the number system using concrete objects and written and mental strategies. We will practise applying our knowledge of number to addition and subtraction problems, moving onto using written representations. We will learn to use key mathematical vocabulary in class discussions.

Science

The children will learn about animals, including humans, and the things we need to survive and maintain a healthy lifestyle. We will also identify a range of common animals and sort them into simple groups.

History

The children will share past and present events in their own lives and in the lives of family members. We will also learn about the Gunpowder Plot and other events that have led to celebrations around the world.

PSHE/RSE

Over the course of the year, we will follow the PSHE Matters Document and the RSE Curriculum for Derbyshire. We will look at the following themes: Friendships and Relationships, Safety, Diversity and Health.

Art / DT

The children will develop a wide range of art techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line and shape. We will also look at the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers as we learn about different celebrations from around the world.

Music

The children will use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. They will play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

PΕ

The children will practise basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching and apply these to a range of games.

RE

The children will consider the people who are special to them and what makes a person inspiring. We will also consider how we show we care for others.

Geography

We will learn about Harvest Festival and how it is celebrated around the world. We will compare our local area to that of a small area in a contrasting non-European country. We will also learn to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.
