

# Long Lane Church of England School: Privacy Notices 2017

## Information about pupils in schools, alternative provision, pupil referral units and children in early years settings

### Data Protection Act 1998: How we use your information

We process personal information relating to our pupils and may receive information about them from their previous school or college, local authority, the Department for Education (DfE) and the Learning Records Service. We hold this personal data to:

- support our pupils' learning
- monitor and report on their progress
- provide appropriate pastoral care; and
- assess the quality of our services

Information about our pupils that we hold will include their contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, any exclusion information, where they go after they leave us and personal characteristics such as their ethnic group, any special educational needs they may have as well as relevant medical information.

In addition once our pupils reach the age of 13, the law requires their secondary school to pass on certain information about them to **Derbyshire District Council** who have responsibilities in relation to the education or training of 13-19 year olds. DCC will be provided with pupils' names and addresses, dates of birth, name(s)/address(es) of their parent(s)/guardian(s) and any other information relevant to their role.

A parent/guardian can ask that no information apart from their child's name, address and date of birth be passed to **Derbyshire County Council** by informing **their child's secondary school**.
